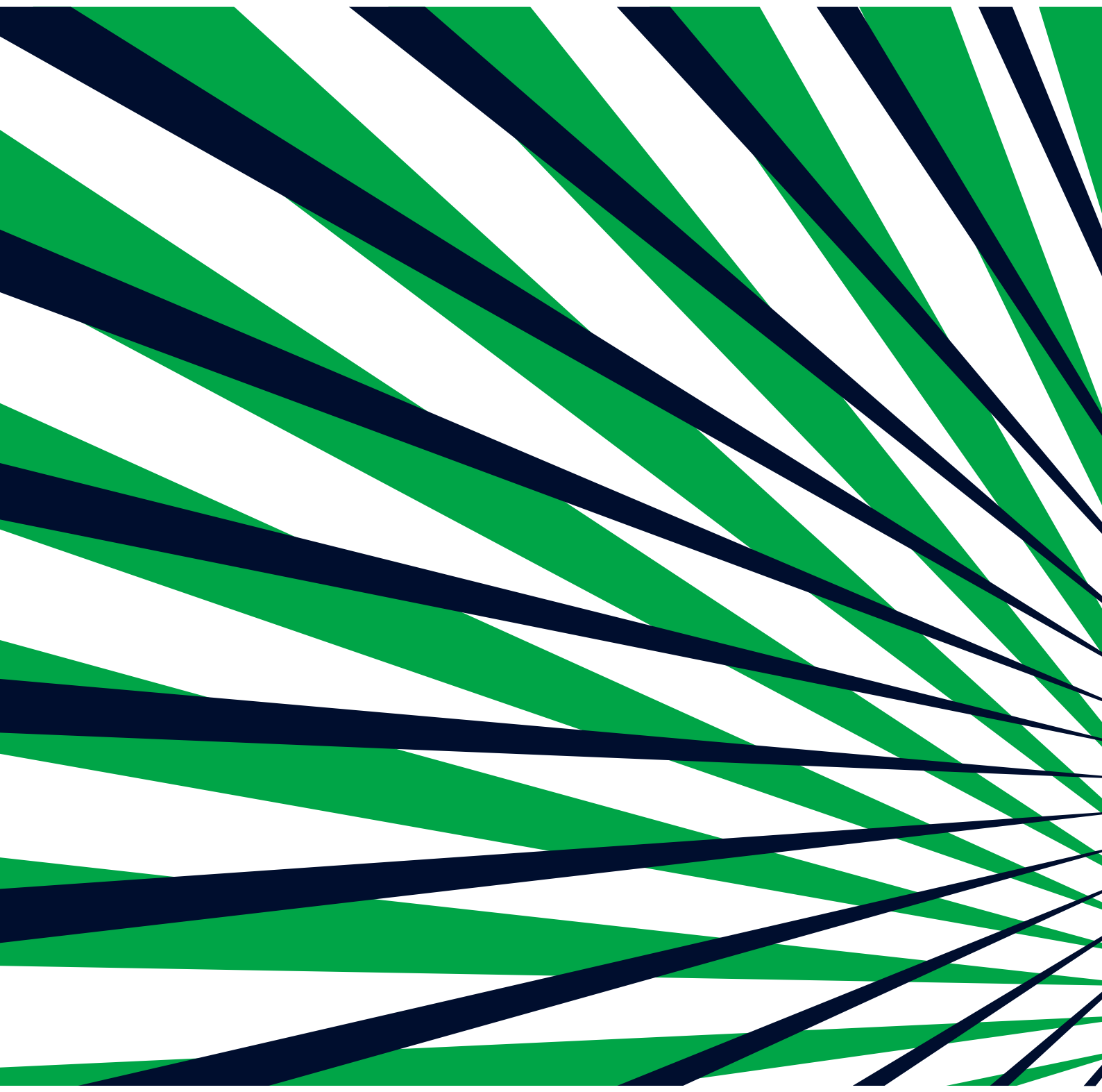

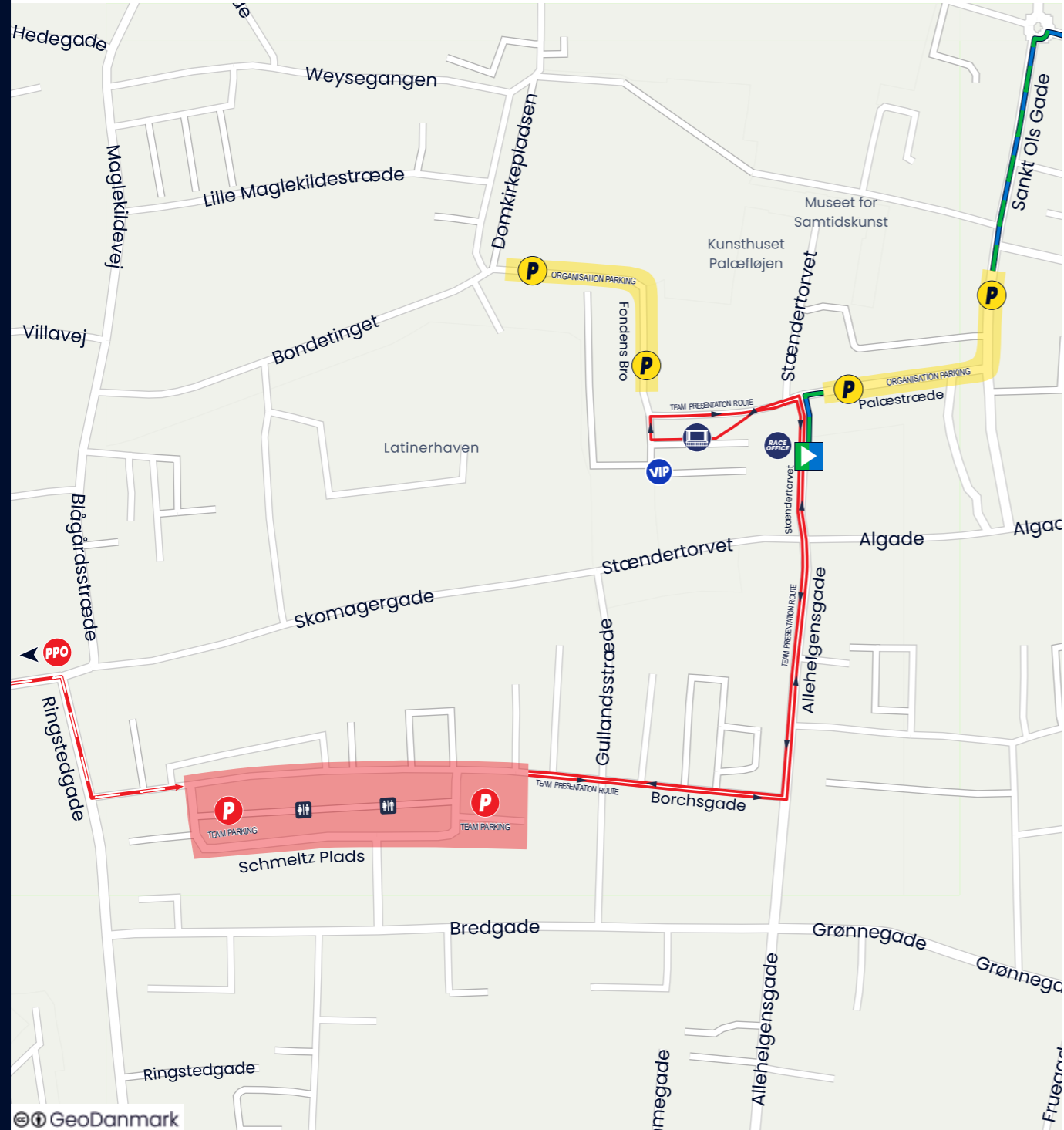

A sustainable event

Copenhagen Sprint aims to reduce the carbon footprint every year, and we want to make the sustainable choices more accessible for both spectators, volunteers, staff and riders. We can't raise the barre alone; everyone must contribute to a sustainable transition.

Here are some of the key initiative we as local organiser committee (LOC) work on:

- **Responsible supply chain:** We continuously work to improve our supply chain according to the principles reduce-reuse-recycle and we push our suppliers to reduce their carbon footprint
- **Sustainable food and drinks:** We serve local plant-based alternatives in the VIP and fan zones to show case that a sustainable diet doesn't have to be dull. We reduce food waste and offer water bottle refill stations in the spectator areas
- **Waste and recycling:** We reduce waste by reusing visuals each year. We upcycle non-reusable textiles, and we work with authorities to recycle as much of our waste as possible.
- **Sustainable transport:** We promote cycling, public transport and electric vehicles to/ from and within the race
- **Social inclusion:** We deliver a cycling for all event and welcome volunteers with various disabilities to be an inclusive event.

ARTICLE 1 – ORGANISATION

Copenhagen Sprint is organized by World Tour CPH P/S, a company of the Danish Cycling Federation, in partnership with Municipalities of Roskilde and Copenhagen, Sport Event Denmark, Wonderful Copenhagen, the Danish Ministry of Culture and Ministry of Business. The race is to be held in accordance with the regulations of the International Cycling Union (UCI). The race will take place on 13 June 2026.

ARTICLE 2 – TYPE OF EVENT

The race, registered on the UCI Women's WorldTour (1.WWT) international calendar, is reserved to riders belonging to the Women Elite and Women U23 category. The points will be awarded for the "Individual UCI World Ranking" in compliance with UCI articles 2.10.011/2.10.017.

ARTICLE 3 – PARTICIPANTS

Copenhagen Sprint is open to all UCI Women's WorldTeams, invited UCI Women's ProTeams and UCI Women's Continental Teams and national team of the organising country in events determined by the UCI, in accordance with the UCI regulations article 2.1.005. In UCI Women's WorldTour one-day events, the number of starting riders per team is 6, in accordance with article 2.2.003. Entering the event implies each participant/team fully accepts all provisions laid out in these regulations and undertakes responsibility to respect them.

ARTICLE 4 – RACE HEADQUARTERS

The Race Headquarters open on Friday 12 June 2026 between 16:00 and 21:00 at Comwell Roskilde, Vestre Kirkevej 12, DK-4000 Roskilde. Refer to the chapter Race Headquarters for further information on the opening hours of the Race Headquarters.

ARTICLE 5 – RADIO TOUR

Information during the race will be broadcast on a closed 4G/LTE connection. Every team will receive a handheld radio. Refer to the chapter Radio Tour for more information. Each team accepts responsibility for their radios. Failure to deliver back radios before the end of 13 June will result in a fee.

ARTICLE 6 – FEED AND WASTE ZONES

In line with safety and environmental protection, as well as UCI regulations article 2.3.025, 2.3.025 bis and 2.3.027, it is strictly forbidden to dispose of food waste, feeding bags, drink containers, or any other items outside of the designated zones. The use of glass containers is also prohibited.

Riders are only allowed to dispose of waste in the Feed and Waste Zones according to the route description. Feeding is not allowed in the last 20 km of the race.

ARTICLE 7 – NEUTRAL SERVICE

The neutral service team will be provided by Neutral Service Team DK. The service is handled by 2 neutral service cars and 1 neutral service MC.

ARTICLE 8 – TEAM VEHICLES

In accordance with the UCI regulations article 2.6.033 each team is allowed to enter one vehicle in the race convoy.

ARTICLE 9 – TIME LIMITS

All riders must finish within a set time limit of the winning time + 8% in accordance with UCI regulations article 2.3.039. Riders finishing outside this time limit will not be included in the classification.

ARTICLE 10 – GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

The General Classification will be established according to the order crossing the finishing line, in accordance with article 2.3.037 of the UCI Regulations.

ARTICLE 11 – TOWN SPRINT CLASSIFICATION

During the race three town sprints will decide the Town Sprint Classification. During each sprint the first 3 riders to cross the line will receive points according to the following table:

No. 1	3 p
No. 2	2 p
No. 3	1 p

The Town Sprint Classification is drawn up by the sum of points obtained from each of the sprints.

In the event of a tie in the classification the following criteria shall apply to establish a classification:

- I. Number of Town Sprints won
- II. Number of second places in Town Sprints
- III. Number of third places in Town Sprints
- IV. Final General Classification.

ARTICLE 13 – PRELIMINARY OPERATIONS AT THE START AND AWARDS CEREMONY

13.1 In accordance with article 2.3.009 of the UCI regulations, all riders on the same team must attend the Team Presentation at the specified time in the Team Presentation Schedule. All riders must sign the official signature sheet.

13.2 In accordance with articles 1.2.112 and 2.3.046 of the UCI regulations, the following riders must attend the official awards ceremony:

- The three best placed riders in the General Classification
- The winner of the Town Sprint Classification

The riders shall attend the awards ceremony no later than 10 minutes after crossing the finish line.

13.3 The three best placed riders in the General Classification shall attend a press conference in accordance with UCI regulations articles 2.2.081-2.2.082. The press conference will be held in conjunction with the mixed zone interviews.

ARTICLE 14 – ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

Anti-doping tests are carried out under the authority of the I.T.A. by designated officials. They will take place just behind the victory podium at Statens Museum for Kunst (SMK), Sølvgade 48-50, DK-1307 Indre By, Copenhagen. The UCI antidoping regulations are entirely applicable to the event.

ARTICLE 15 – IMAGE AND VIDEO RIGHTS, ADVERTISEMENTS, AND OTHER RIGHTS

15.1 In order to enable the promotion of the event the participating teams, and consequently, their riders authorise and recognise the Organiser as the entity to hold without any economic benefit the public communication rights of the race. Through participating in the event, the Organiser is granted the rights to reproduce, represent and display the participants names, image, voice, biography, track record, professional profile etc. as well as the brands of their equipment manufacturers and personal or team sponsors.

15.2 This authorisation extends to the sponsor team trademark images and includes any form or format, whether current or future, including advertisements and commercial goals. The rights are granted with no limitations other than those described herein, and for the period of time currently agreed upon according to legislative rules and the broadcast and promotion of the event and future editions.

15.3 Should the Organiser lend images to third parties for commercial or promotional goals, the use of the name, image, voice, biography, track record, professional profile, and team trademark will not be permitted without explicit authorisation from the rider, team, or sponsor.

15.4 It is strictly forbidden for the commercial firms that sponsor the participating teams to engage in any type of advertising without prior and express written authorisation from the Organiser of the event.

ARTICLE 16 – APPLICABLE LAW AND SANCTIONS

All participants are subject to Danish law. The organiser reserves the right to take necessary actions, including exclusion from the race of riders, staff, or entire teams, for failing to adhere to national laws and thereby damaging the image of the race and the sport.

ARTICLE 17 – PENALTIES

The UCI penalty scale shall apply to the event.

ARTICLE 18 – RESPONSIBILITY

The Organisation cannot be held responsible for any accident caused or received by either the riders, team staff, technical and assistant personnel, team guests, or general supporters of the event.

Race Regulations

ARTICLE 1 – ORGANISATION

Copenhagen Sprint is organized by World Tour CPH P/S, a company of the Danish Cycling Federation, in partnership with Municipalities of Roskilde and Copenhagen, Sport Event Denmark, Wonderful Copenhagen, the Danish Ministry of Culture and Ministry of Business. The race is to be held in accordance with the regulations of the International Cycling Union (UCI). The race will take place on 14 June 2026.

ARTICLE 2 – TYPE OF EVENT

The race, registered on the UCI WorldTour (1.UWT) international calendar, is reserved to riders belonging to the Men Elite and Men U23 category. Points will be awarded for the "Individual UCI World Ranking" in compliance with UCI articles 2.10.002/2.10.008.

ARTICLE 3 – PARTICIPANTS

Copenhagen Sprint is open to all UCI Men's WorldTeams, invited UCI Men's ProTeams and national team of the organising country in events determined by the PCC, in accordance with the UCI regulations article 2.1.005. In UCI WorldTour one-day events, the number of starting riders per team is 7, in accordance with article 2.2.003. Entering the event implies each participant/team fully accepts all provisions laid out in these regulations and undertakes responsibility to respect them.

ARTICLE 4 – RACE HEADQUARTERS

The Race Headquarters will be open on Saturday 13 June 2026 between 17:00 and 21:00 at City Hall Copenhagen. Refer to the chapter Race Headquarters for further information on the opening hours of the Race Headquarters.

ARTICLE 5 – RADIO TOUR

Information during the race will be broadcast on a closed 4G/LTE connection. Every team will receive a handheld radio. Refer to the chapter Radio Tour for more information. Each team accepts responsibility for their radios. Failure to deliver back radios before the end of 13 June will result in a fee.

ARTICLE 6 – FEED AND WASTE ZONES

In line with safety and environmental protection, as well as UCI regulations article 2.3.025, 2.3.025 bis and 2.3.027, it is strictly forbidden to dispose of food waste, feeding bags, drink containers, or any other items outside of the designated zones. The use of glass containers is also prohibited

In the circuit 170.6 km, 181.9 km, 192.2 km, 202.5 km

Riders are only allowed to dispose of waste in the Feed and Waste Zones according to the route description. Feeding is not allowed in the last 20 km of the race.

ARTICLE 7 – NEUTRAL SERVICE

The neutral service team will be provided by Neutral Service Team DK. The service is handled by 2 neutral service cars and 1 neutral service MC.

ARTICLE 8 – TEAM VEHICLES

In accordance with the UCI regulations article 2.3.017 each team is allowed to enter two vehicles in the race convoy. However, only one team car is allowed on the local final circuit. The second car must exit the route when passing the deviation the first time.

ARTICLE 9 – TIME LIMITS

All riders must finish within a set time limit of the winning time + 8% in accordance with UCI regulations article 2.3.039. Riders finishing outside this time limit will not be included in the classification.

ARTICLE 10 – GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

The General Classification will be established according to the order of crossing the finishing line, in accordance with article 2.3.037 of the UCI Regulations.

ARTICLE 11 – TOWN SPRINT CLASSIFICATION

During the race three town sprints will decide the Town Sprint Classification. During each sprint the first 3 riders to cross the line will receive points according to the following table:

No. 1 **3p**
No. 2 **2p**
No. 3 **1p**

The Town Sprint Classification is drawn up by the sum of points obtained from each of the sprints.

In the event of a tie in the classification the following criteria shall apply to establish a classification:

- I. Number of Town Sprints won
- II. Number of second places in Town Sprints
- III. Number of third places in Town Sprints
- IV. Final General Classification

Only riders who have finished the race within the time limit, is applicable in the Town Sprint Classification.

The winner of the Town Sprint Competition will win a prize from Tivoli Gardens Copenhagen including

ARTICLE 13 – PRELIMINARY OPERATIONS AT THE START AND AWARDS CEREMONY

13.1 In accordance with article 2.3.009 of the UCI regulations, all riders on the same team must attend the Team Presentation at the specified time in the Team Presentation Schedule. All riders must sign the official signature sheet

13.2 In accordance with articles 1.2.112 and 2.3.046 of the UCI regulations, the following riders must attend the official awards ceremony:

- The three best placed riders in the General Classification
- The winner of the Town Sprint Classification

The riders will present themselves to the podium in a time limit of 10 minutes of crossing the finish line.

13.3 The three best placed riders in the General Classification shall attend a press conference in accordance with UCI regulations articles 2.2.081-2.2.082. The press conference will be held in conjunction with the mixed zone interviews.

ARTICLE 14 – ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

Anti-doping tests are carried out under the authority of the I.T.A. by designated officials. They will take place just behind the victory podium at Statens Museum for Kunst (SMK), Sølvgade 48-50, DK-1307 Indre By, Copenhagen. The UCI antidoping regulations are entirely applicable to the event.

ARTICLE 15 – IMAGE AND VIDEO RIGHTS, ADVERTISEMENTS, AND OTHER RIGHTS

15.1 In order to enable the promotion of the event the participating teams, and consequently, their riders authorise and recognise the Organiser as the entity to hold without any economic benefit the public communication rights of the race. Through participating in the event, the Organiser is granted the rights to reproduce, represent and display the participants names, image, voice, biography, track record, professional profile etc. as well as the brands of their equipment manufacturers and personal or team sponsors

15.2 This authorisation extends to the sponsor team trademark images and includes any form or format, whether current or future, including advertisements and commercial goals. The rights are granted with no limitations other than those described herein, and for the period of time currently agreed upon according to legislative rules and the broadcast and promotion of the event and future editions.

15.3 Should the Organiser lend images to third parties for commercial or promotional goals, the use of the name, image, voice, biography, track record, professional profile, and team trademark will not be permitted without explicit authorisation from the rider, team, or sponsor.

15.4 It is strictly forbidden for the commercial firms that sponsor the participating teams to engage in any type of advertising without prior and express written authorisation from the Organiser of the event.

ARTICLE 16 – APPLICABLE LAW AND SANCTIONS

All participants are subject to Danish law. The organiser reserves the right to take necessary actions, including exclusion from the race of riders, staff, or entire teams, for failing to adhere to national laws and thereby damaging the image of the race and the sport.

ARTICLE 17 – PENALTIES

The UCI penalty scale shall apply to the event.

ARTICLE 18 – RESPONSIBILITY

The Organisation cannot be held responsible for any accident caused or received by either the riders, team staff, technical and assistant personnel, team guests, or general supporters of the event.

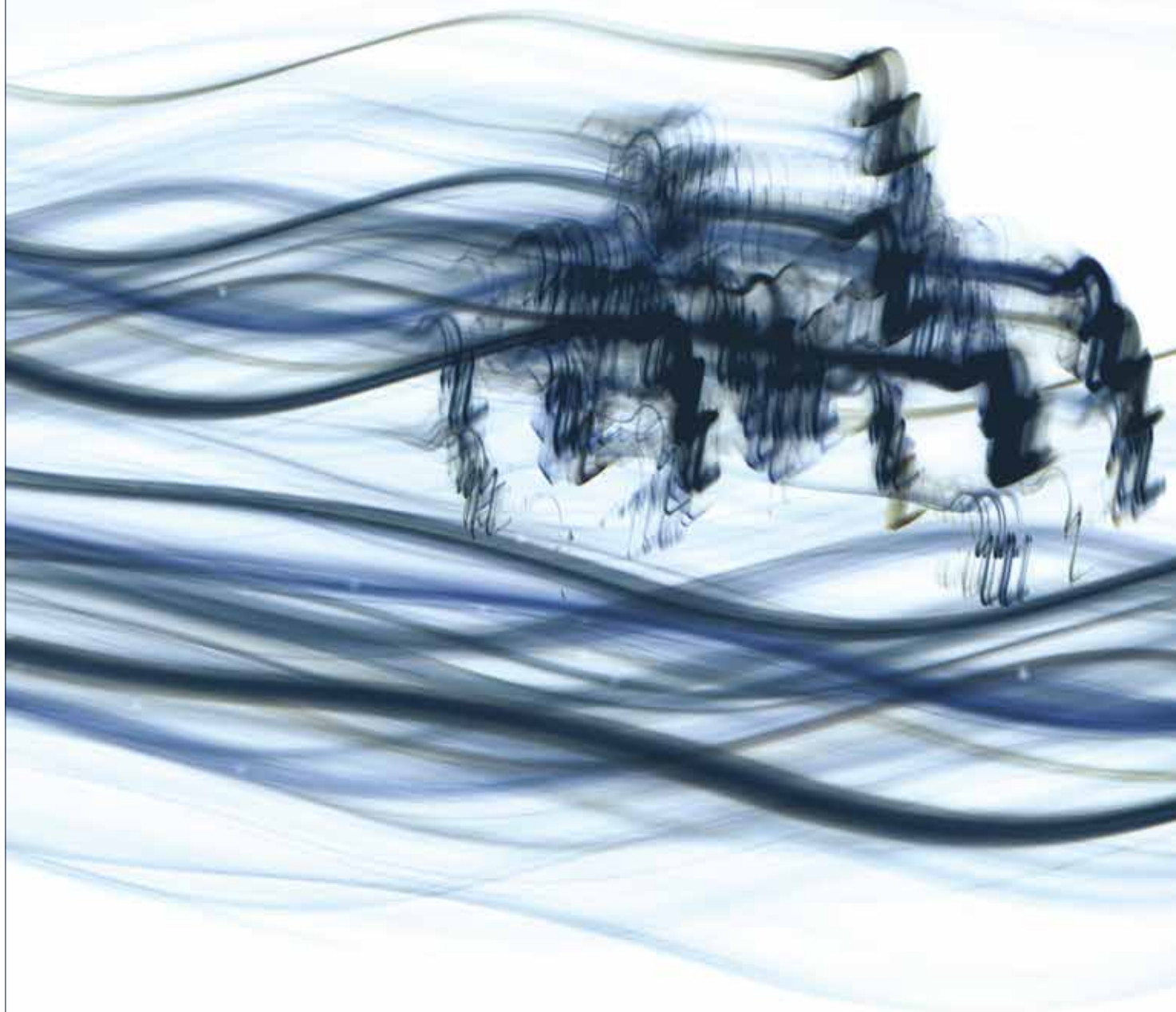
